Sustainable Resource Policy


All operations and processes undertaken by Red Stag Timber Ltd will be performed in a manner that is environmentally responsible.

To comply with this policy Red Stag Timber will, wherever practicable and commercially viable, procure and process wood fibre from logs originating from resources understood to be sustainable and replenishable via cyclical plantation re-planting or via an approved selective logging process.

Red Stag Timber will thus avoid using wood-fibre that has knowingly been harvested:

- From illegally harvested wood;
- From forests where traditional rights and or civil rights are violated;
- From forests where high conservation values are threatened by management activities;
- From natural forests being converted to plantations or non-forest use;
- From forests in which genetically modified trees are planted

Red Stag Timber will have a documented procedure to verify that all log procurement is from certified or controlled environments to ensure this Sustainable Resource Policy is adhered to.
